## Art Bags

Carry on or Backpack
I use a 44 liter backpack for my oil painting gear. When traveling I try to go down to a 32 or so if necessary. I can usually fit it empty into the paint checked bag. Otherwise I will carry on my 32 as a second carry on which will fit under a seat)

Small Sketch Book, pencils (can go in checked also)
Brushes
Sun screen
Bug repellent
Small hand sanitizer
Small first aid kit (Coleman makes a mint tin size. Good to have)

## Checked Bag

Smaller canvas box $8 \times 10$ or $11 \times 14$
Strap (used for holding paper towel roll if used or other things)
Plastic bags (For oily towells)
A couple of clamps (Theatrical Clamps just handy to have)
Pliers (Small channel locks)or stuck paint tubes)
Walnut oil (ALKYD)
Liquin Original
Murphys Cleaner (Small container shampoo size)
Other mediums?
Clothing (These are my must have for painting trip. Other stuff you would normally pack is not listed). This is all stuff that can go into paint kit if necessary.

Two sets under armor (Cold Weather)
Coat (Usually a windbreaker/rain slicker)
Gloves - In back pack if cold weather
Ear flap hat -back pack if cold weather
Cowboy Hat (My painting hat)
Ball cap (2nd painting hat)
